1. Disc Golf is played like ball golf, using a self-propelled flying disc. One stroke is counted for each throw and when a penalty is incurred. The winner is the golfer with the lowest score.
2. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the least amount of strokes from the previous hole(s) is first to tee-off on the next hole.
3. A disc that makes it into the basket is a successful completion of that hole.
4. Any disc that comes to rest more than 2 meters (6 1/2 feet) above the ground is considered unplayable. The disc must be thrown from the ground directly below the disc. 1 throw penalty.
5. A throw that lands out-of-bounds (OB) must be played from the point where the disc went OB. Water (100% wet), roads, pavilions, athletic areas and walkways are normal disc OB. 1 throw penalty.
6. **NEVER THROW UNTIL THE PLAYERS AHEAD OF YOU ARE OUT OF RANGE AND UNTIL THE FAIRWAY IS COMPLETELY CLEAR OF SPECTATORS AND PARK USERS. ALL OTHER PARK USERS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY.**
