

DISC GOLF COURSE RULES

GENERAL	Disc Golf is played much like ball golf. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown or when a penalty is incurred. Lowest score wins.
TEE THROWS	Tee throws must be made from within or behind the designated tee area.
LIE	The spot on or directly underneath the spot where the previous throw landed.
THROWING ORDER	After teeing-off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the fewest throws on the previous hole is the first to tee-off.
FAIRWAY THROWS	Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on the lie. A run-up and a normal follow-through after the release are not allowed.
PUTT THROW	Within 10 yards of the basket, a player may not step past the point of his lie in making his putt throw. Falling or jumping putts are not allowed.
UNPLAYABLE LIE	Any disc that comes to rest more than 6 feet above the ground is considered an unplayable lie. After being declared unplayable, the disc must be thrown from the new lie on the ground, directly underneath the unplayable lie (1 throw penalty).
OUT OF BOUNDS	A throw that lands out of bounds must be played from the point where the disc went out of bounds. Water hazards and public roads are always out of bounds (1 throw penalty).
