RULES

- Players must tee off from the designated tee area. Be sure the players and other park users are in front of you and out of range.
- When playing a hole, the player farthest away from the basket throws first.
- The hole is complete when a player's disc lands in the basket or chains.
- The player with the least number of throws on the last hole tees off first on the next hole.
- The spot where your previous throw landed is called the "lie." To begin your next throw, your lead foot must be within 11 inches directly behind the lie. The other foot may be no closer to the hole than the lie. A run-up with natural follow through after release is allowed.
- Any disc that comes to rest above the ground (in a tree or a bush), is considered an unplayable lie. The disc must be thrown from the lie on the ground directly beneath the unplayable lie (one stroke penalty).

OUT OF BOUNDS

- On or across any paved surface on any hole
- To the right or left (depending on which basket is played) of the fence on Hole 14
- Hole 9's fairway on Hole 4
- Hole 4's fairway on Hole 9

If your disc lands out of bounds, the next throw is from the point where it went out of bounds. There is a one stroke penalty.
