

Program Elements

Disc Golf:

The present 9-hole disc golf area of the park works but is in extremely poor condition. Most of the actual elements such as the disc pole holes, tee pads, tee signs and general course condition are in need of work. Although the course is used primarily by local youth and college students, people of all ages come from all over the country to play this challenging course. This course and its support from users could meet state or even national recognition. The detail design needs to be coordinated closely with the local youth and supporters.

Action:

- Design and install an 18-hole disc golf course.
- Install all new disc pole holes, tee pads and tee signing.
- Install information kiosks, starting at location of tee #1 – explanation of game to non-users or novice players.
- Set rules and procedures to the game and course.
- Provide other amenities such as benches, signing, shelters, parking, picnic tables, and grills.
- Improve the turf conditions of the course.
