



Disc Golf Basics

Tee Throws

Tee shots must be made from inside of the designated area of the Tee box

Lie

The spot where the previous shot has landed, throw from this spot.

Throwing Order

After teeing off the player that is farthest from the hole throws first.

The player with the lowest score on the last hole throws first on the next hole.

Fairway Throws

Fairway shots must be taken with the foot closest to the hole on the lie.

A run up and follow through are allowed after the disc is released.

Holing Out

When a disc comes to rest inside the basket, or in the chains the hole is considered completed and the players score recorded. Follow throughs or falling putts are not allowed inside of 10 meters.

Out of Bounds

A throw that lands out-of-bounds must be played from 1 meter in bounds from where the disc went out. Water hazards and public roads are always O. B.

Course Details

#1 This hole has a Mandatory object, the disc must pass the tree on the side the deer is facing, If you pass the tree on the right it is a 1 stroke penalty, throw your next shot from the Drop Zone to the left of the tree.

#2 The road and opposite side are O.B. 1 stroke penalty drop 1 meter in from where your disc went out.

#3 The drop zone for the mandatory is the Tee box, re-drive. The road and opposite side are O.B.

#4 Water along the right side, if you go in the water 1 stroke penalty, drop 1 meter in bounds.

#5 The Drop Zone is for the pond and under the bridge, if you go in the creek anywhere else drop on the far side of the creek where your disc went in the water.

#7 The area inside the fence-the sink hole- is O.B. the Drop Zone is on the right near the creek. There is no casual water on this hole, if there is water in the creek treat it as a water hazard, 1 stroke penalty and 1 meter relief drop to play.

Holes 3,4,6,and 9 play as recreational par fours.
