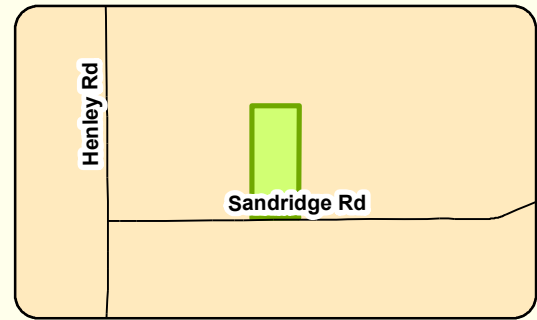


## Location Map



Ronnie VanZant Memorial Park is a 90 acre complex that offers both active and passive recreational activities. Included in the park are two basketball courts, four tennis courts, one soccer field, one softball field, a playground, a volleyball court, a frisbee golf course, and 11 covered pavilions. Those who prefer to take it a little slower can enjoy a 3 acre fishing pond managed by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and a system of nature trails that encircle the pond.
