16. An uphill shot over a dry creek bed, with a very pretty green grassy fairway with pine trees. It's serene and loaded with natural beauty. Hole 2 has a cool ravine near the basket.

Toughest Hole(s)

Short: 17 & 18. Both holes are tight, pretty long, and have a White Score Avg of 3.5. Long: 17. Long and tight in the trees with an accurate approach needed; it has a Blue Score Avg of 3.5.

Comments

Lots of pretty trees, nice grass, moderate elevation changes, and a nearby river make this course a pleasure to play. Two sets of tees offer variety and concrete tee pads make for sure footing.
