

RULES

All visitors are required to be familiar with the current rules from the membership directory. Failure to comply could result in the loss of your use privilege. Members are responsible for their guest's behavior. Some basic reminders from the directory:

- Membership cards** are only honored for the person(s) named on the card. A driver's license is required when checking in. Non-member visits to Leavenworth Thousands Trails—only once a year.
- Speed limit is 5 mph.** This includes bikes. "Don't Dust Your Neighbors."
- Pets** must be on a 10 foot maximum leash and be under the control of the owner at all times. They must be cleaned up after.
- Quiet hours** are 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. Fires must be completely extinguished by 11 p.m. and no check ins after 10 p.m.
- Camping vehicles** must be occupied every night.
- All campsites** are "first come, first choice," except by manager's exception.
- Children** must be supervised by parents at all times.
- Swimming Pool** is used at your own risk: Warning — No Lifeguard.
- Smoking Policies:** All T.T. buildings and rental units are Non Smoking in accordance with our health and fire prevention goals. Please use ash-trays located throughout Preserve.
- Fires** may be burned in designated pits or BBQs. Burning may be banned by the USFS when conditions mandate. Fires must be completely extinguished when unattended. Fireworks are illegal.
- Clotheslines** must be confined to your rig and not allowed on trees or other Preserve property.
- Help us to maintain a clean, natural, and litter-free camp.
- Any unsafe actions may result in eviction. Contact security for a complete list of rules.
- Rental check in** is 4 p.m. Check out by Noon.

Food Service — Our Chuck Wagon is located on the Country Store Path Summer Weekends.

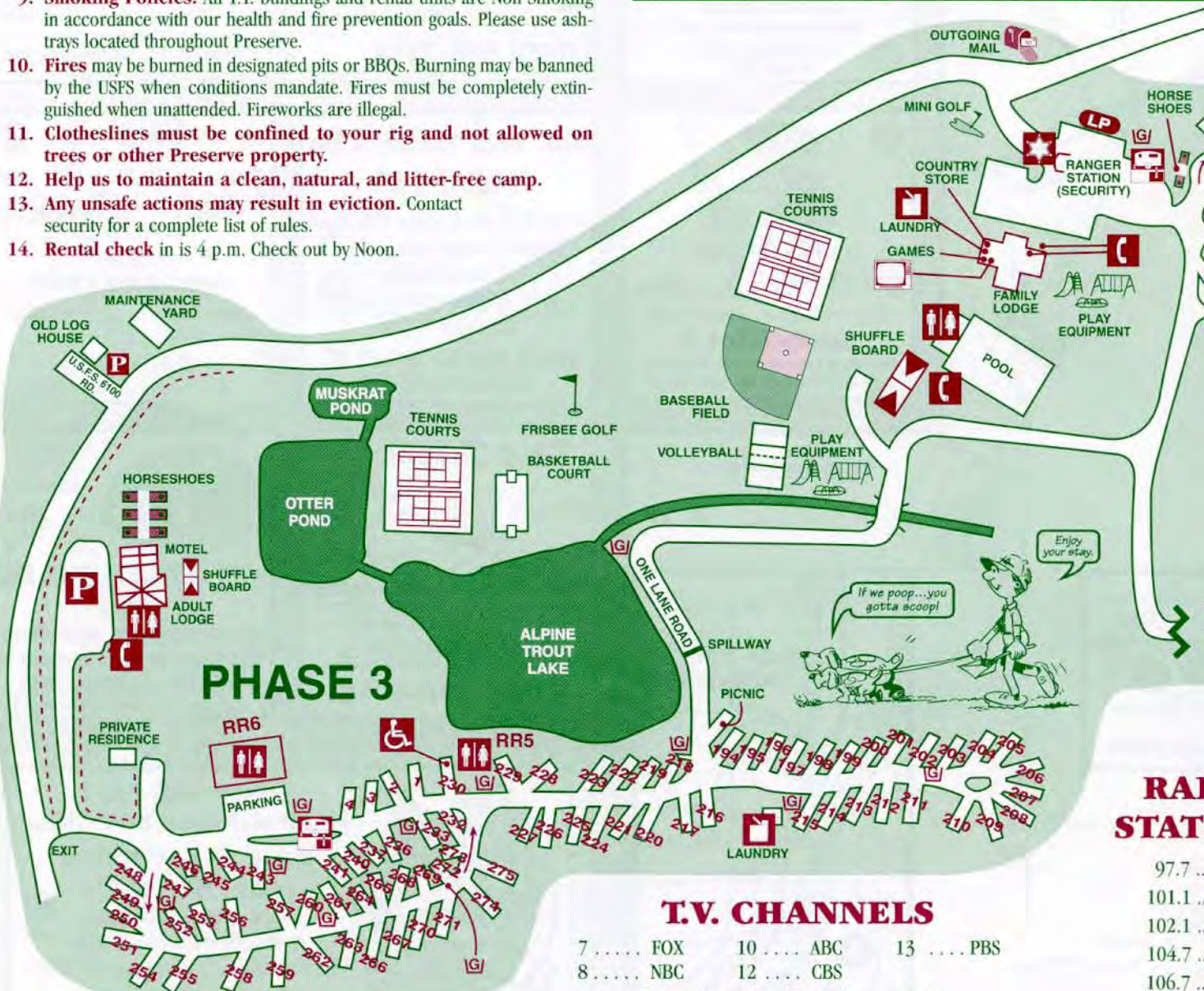

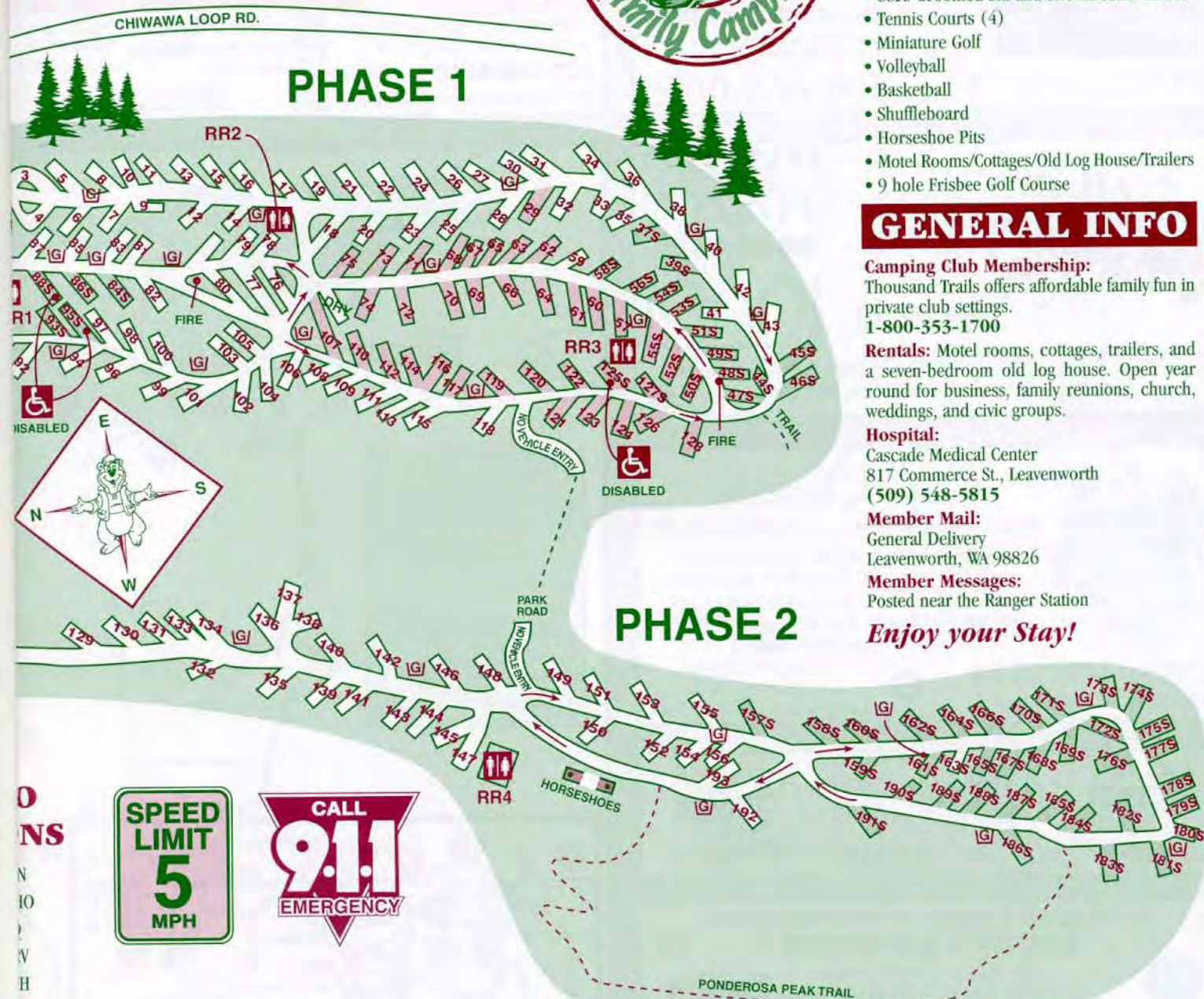
