

# WELCOME TO MURDOCK PARK DISC GOLF COURSE

Murdock Park is home to an 18 hole disc golf course with both PRO (ORANGE) and AM (WHITE) tee-pads for each basket. Tee-pad numbers are color coded accordingly.

**PLEASE WATCH FOR OTHER USERS OF THE PARK AND ALERT THEM OF YOUR INTENT TO THROW. MOUNTAIN BIKE USAGE IS COMMON IN THE HEAVILY WOODED NORTHERN PORTION OF THE COURSE. BE COURTEOUS AND THROW SAFELY!**

The map shows 18 holes with their respective tees and baskets. Holes 1-13 are in the northern wooded area, while holes 14-18 are in the southern area. Red areas indicate OB zones, including a wood border along a cliff for hole 14, fences, and sidewalks. Situational OB lines are shown for holes 4 and 8. A swamp area is also marked.

### MURDOCK PARK COURSE RULES

- Red areas on the course map indicate OB (Out of Bounds) areas. All fences and sidewalks bordering roads are OB. An OB shot suffers a 1 stroke penalty and is played from the spot it was last in bounds.
- When playing from the #14 Orange tee, a shot which lands OB (left of wood border along cliff) suffers a 1 stroke penalty and the player's next (3rd) throw shall be from the #14 White tee. Any shot other than a tee shot from the #14 Orange tee which lands OB is played from the spot it went OB with a 1 stroke penalty.
- Holes #4 & #8 use a walking path to indicate situational OB lines. The walking path and beyond are OB for these holes only.
- All water (including the swamp) is Casual Water. Play the disc where it lies or from any point behind the disc in a straight line from the basket.
