

## Layout

There are two overlapping layouts.

On Saturday, we'll play 2 rounds on the 18-hole **Diamond** layout.

On Sunday, we'll play 2 rounds on the 18-hole **Garnet** layout. Note hole numbers on card:

( 1A-1B-1C-2-3-G6-G7-12-13-14A-14B-15-15B-16-17A-17B-17C-18 )

## General Rules

**Creeks and Pond** are O.B. when surrounded by water. Beyond creeks is O.B. on holes #11 & #14/14B only.

**Roads** and beyond are O.B. except on Holes 14/14B and 17A, where it's not O.B.

**2-Meter Rule** is not in effect.

**Briars** may be stomped down, broken, or removed at any location. This includes briars between lie and basket, briars in the way of stance, reach back, or follow-through---*any* briars.

**Debris piles** are casual hazards.

**Strings, landscape timbers, orange stakes or flags** define some O.B.s, such as the center of creek on #14 where it runs dry, the edge of the road on #12 & #16, and between the stakes on #9. Where string is not present, O.B. is defined by the road or creek, sight lines between flags or orange stakes, and group's best judgement.

**Bridges** are inbounds, even where located above O.B.

**Gulleys** in fairway on 17A and 17-Diamond are casual obstacles. You may take up to 5 meter relief, without penalty.

**Provisionals** should be thrown if there are any doubts.

## Specific Rules & Situations

**HOLE 1A (Garnet layout)**---Advanced Women and Recs will tee from short tee/1st drop zone. Hole plays as an island hole; drive must come to rest inside timbers. If not, it's O.B.; play from 1st drop zone drop zone, marked by black stakes. If throw from drop zone does not come to rest inside timbers, throw from drop 2nd drop zone (just outside green).

**HOLE 6**---Chris' yard is O.B., marked by string, orange flags, and/or landscape timbers. *Dual tee-pad; don't throw to wrong basket. Hole 9 has priority.*

**HOLE 9**---O.B. is defined by a line of orange flags, and string between them. In the absence of string, sight along flags. *Dual tee-pad; don't throw to wrong basket. Hole 9 has priority. Note that if you start your drive off to the left and it never comes back inbounds, you'll be re-teeing.*

**HOLE 11**---Creek and beyond are O.B. If you land between water and white flags, you may take casual relief to drop zone on boulder. If you go O.B. below the white flags, you may take lie at drop zone on boulder. *Caution: Do not throw at the #14 basket, visible from tee. The #11 basket is uphill.*

**GARNET 7**---Creek is O.B. but tee side of creek is inbounds (unlike 11). See *Hole 11* for rules on the white flags.

**HOLE 12**---An "island hole". Only the basket side of the road is inbounds; drive must come to rest across road. If it does not, you are O.B. and your lie is the drop zone halfway down fairway (black stakes). Throw from drop zone must land across road, or take another stroke and throw again. Once a shot comes to rest over road, play normal O.B. If disc lands in creek, play where it went in (not from drop zone).

**HOLE 13**---Creek is O.B. Beyond fence is O.B. *If your disc goes over fence, leave it until after round and let us know; we will retrieve it.*

**HOLE 14 (Diamond layout)**---Creeks and beyond are O.B. Inside fenced pasture is O.B. Road is not O.B.

**HOLE 14A (Garnet layout)**---Inside fenced pasture is O.B. Road is not O.B.

**HOLE 14B (Garnet layout)**---Creeks and beyond are O.B. Road is not O.B.

**HOLE 15**---Creek is O.B. *Caution on Diamond layout to yield to players playing 17 Diamond before walking to Hole 16.*

**HOLE 15B (Garnet layout)**---Pond and creek are O.B..

**HOLE 16 (Garnet layout)**---Advanced Grandmasters, Advanced Women, Intermediates, and Recs will tee from Intermediate Tee. This is an "island hole"; drive must come to rest between pond and road. If not, it is O.B. and lie is drop zone at Intermediate Tee. *(Groups teeing from Intermediate tee will re-tee).* If throw from drop zone lands O.B., play it where it went O.B.

**HOLE 16 (Diamond layout)**---Drive plays the same as the Garnet layout, as an "island hole". The left shore of the pond, from the tee to the bridge, is all O.B. *You must land on right side of the pond---unless you think you can reach basket from the tee. Distance is based on this dogleg; straight distance is about 525'.*

**HOLE 17A**--- Road is not O.B. Gulleys are casual obstacles; you may take up to 5 meter relief without penalty.

**HOLE 17B (Garnet layout)**---Cedar tree (with dog head) is mandatory; throw must pass to left, or go to drop zone (black stakes). Mando is defined by center trunk of tree.

**HOLE 17 (Diamond layout)**--- Pond is O.B. Gulleys are casual obstacles; you may take up to 5 meter relief, without penalty.

**HOLE 18**---The "Quarry" (dirt pit) before the basket is O.B., marked by flags, timbers, and/or string. On the side of the mound facing the quarry is a "casual relief zone"; if you land there, take relief straight back, without penalty. *Caution: Crossing fairways. Hole 1 has right-of-way; be sure they are not throwing or have walked past before driving.*
